HOW ARE DISTRICTS DRAWN?

Process	 State Legislature draws the lines State Supreme Court will review the plan if a registered voter petitions
State-Level Criteria Ranked: No	 Contiguity for House and Senate Follow political boundaries for House and Senate Single-member districts for Senate
Public Hearings	No redistricting specific provisions
Timing	 Plan must be adopted during the first session after the federal census for the House and Senate Plan is affective for 10 years

• Plan is effective for 10 years

Process

- State Legislature draws the lines
- Governor can veto the plan
- State Supreme Court has jurisdiction to hear lawsuits concerning congressional districts
